

Bylaw 9. Regional Conventions

INTRODUCTION

Under the Constitution of the Photographic Society of New Zealand Inc. (PSNZ) the Executive Officers have been given the power to create and set Bylaws that are applicable to the description of specific events, activities, jobs, portfolios and/or publications that fall within the operations of the Society.

Objectives of this Bylaw

This Bylaw is intended to outline the processes and jurisdiction given to the PSNZ affiliated club (Assisting Club) working with the PSNZ Events subcommittee for the conduct of a PSNZ regional convention so that they may organise and host a successful convention that meets the needs and educational objectives of the Society – “Helping Photographers Grow”.

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- (a) The Council has divided New Zealand into two regions based on the major islands:
 - (b) The Society will endeavour to hold annual regional conventions in each island which will last no longer than two (2) days and two (2) nights.
 - (c) Each regional convention will be conducted by the PSNZ Events subcommittee and an Assisting Club from the region, appointed for that purpose by the Council.
 - (d) The Assisting Club will be paid a set fee for their services which will be detailed in the Letter of Offer.
 - (e) The convention must be organised in accordance with the decisions of Council and conveyed through the PSNZ Councillor for Events.
 - (f) The PSNZ Events subcommittee must provide a budget to the Council for approval six months before the event.
 - (g) Full details about the hosting and organisation of a convention are contained in the PSNZ Manual for the Conduct of a Regional Convention and must be referred to for all matters.
