## <u>Rules:</u>



The Canon Online competition is run by the Photographic Society of New Zealand (PSNZ) under the guidance of PSNZ Bylaw 20. 'Canon-Online-Competition-March-2024.

There will be 6 rounds in the Canon Online each calendar year.

Canon Online will operate under the following Rules:

- 1. Any member of PSNZ may submit 1 digital image in each round.
- 2. Images that have received an acceptance or an award in the National Exhibition will be ineligible for entry in Canon Online.
- 3. Entrants must have appropriate rights and permission relating to the subject matter of their entries.
- 4. All pictorial elements in each entry must be captured photographically and must be produced by the entrant (including materials for composite images).
- 5. No image created solely by, or containing elements created, substituted or removed using Generative Artificial Intelligence are permitted.
- 6. All post production must be executed by the photographer.
- 7. Please do not add any watermarks to your entries as the selection is anonymous. All entries with watermarks on will be disqualified.
- 8. The copyright of all images remains with the entrant. PSNZ reserve the right to reproduce, without payment, any image in connection with the competition.
- 9. The Photographic Society of New Zealand Inc accepts no responsibility for any claims relating to your copyright or privacy infringement or disputes.
- 10. The organisers' reserve the right to disqualify an entry that they consider, at their absolute discretion, to be undesirable.
- 11. The selectors' decisions are final. Submission of an entry implies acceptance of the competition rules.
